TODAY'S VERSE: As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.
— Psalm 103:12

THOUGHTS ON TODAY'S VERSE: Now that's a long way - from sun rising to sun setting, that's how far God has removed our sins. But the key word is removed. When we sin and come to God in repentance, God doesn't just forgive our sin; he purifies us of all unrighteousness. What was unholy in me is made righteous in him. What was impure is now clean. What was stained is spotless. Why? How? We can now see more fully what the Psalmist could know only in part. God doesn't see our sin, but Jesus' sacrifice. His blood purifies and cleanses us! Our sin is gone and we are clean.

MY PRAYER: Father of mercies, thank you for not only forgiving my sins, but for removing them. I thank you that I can stand before you holy and without fault because of the blood of Jesus and your gracious desire to forgive. I now ask, Righteous Father, that you strengthen me with your Holy Spirit so that my conduct will reflect your estimate of me in Jesus. In the name of the Christ, your Son and my Savior, I pray. Amen.

A HANDBREADTH

Stretch out your palm. Separate your fingers to the widest. Hold them as far apart as you can. Then consider: "Lord make me to know my end, and what is the measure of my days, that I may know how frail I am. Indeed, You have made my days as handbreadths, and my age is as nothing before You; certainly every man at his best state is but vapor" (Psalm 39:4-5).

Jeanne-Louise Calment was born in Arles, France, on February 21, 1875, and died on August 4, 1997. She lived 122 years and 164 days. She lived a long time, didn't she? Not really. Not when you consider life compared to eternity.

Friend, in terms of the clock, your life is ever so short (Job 14:1-2; James 4:14). Assuming you escape disease, you do not perish in an untimely accident, and your parents had extremely good genes, it is still doubtful that you will live as long as Calment. And even if you do, it will be but a handbreadth.

Max Anders observed, "It matters to God how we use our time. It is something which He gave to us. We do not own it. We are responsible to manage it for Him. It does not mean we must always work. Part of our time should be used in recreation and rest, the development and enjoyment of relationships. But we must be aware of how we use our time, and use it wisely".
