## WHAT JESUS DID

John 20:5 He bent over and looked at the strips of linen lying there but did not go in. 6 Then Peter, who was behind him, arrived and went into the tomb. He saw the strips of linen lying there, 7 as well as the burial cloth that had been around Jesus' head. The cloth was folded up by itself, separate from the linen.

There was a good reason for John's hesitation in entering the tomb. Those linen cloths remained in the exact position **AS IF THE LORD HAD STILL BEEN BOUND IN THEM!**

The position of those medical bandages in which the body was wrapped absolutely demanded the conclusion that **JESUS HAD RISEN THROUGH THEM**, as He had risen **THROUGH** the tomb, leaving them undisturbed, as if He had still been in them! Even the napkin still held the position it had when Jesus' head was still in it. The napkin around the head would not have been connected with the winding shroud.
